Exceptions

In Complete Contents, alphabet navigation doesn't have a labeled grouping; it is not clear to the non-sighted user what the letters represent.

In Search, click select from a list next to Keyword(s) in Poem or other field, the page with a list is displayed with two controls Up and Down; it is not clear what controls are applied to. On the same page there is a list of checkboxes; while the checkboxes are labeled with values, there is no information about what the values apply to. The first checkbox doesn't contain hidden text informing user that it applies to the first line or keyword. On the same page if you conduct a search, the list is updated to show the matches; user is unaware that the list below is updated to show only matches.

Pagination control group in the search results that contain multiple pages is not labeled; non-sighted users are unaware what the number controls are for.

In Search history in Combining searches, search fields are not properly labeled.

	In Search, fields in separate sections like Additional Poet Details, Keyword search, and others do not have sufficient non-visual labeling for a user to understand their purpose. For example, user is not aware that a certain search field belongs to Additional Poet Details. Compliance of this standard was validated by WAVE (web accessibility evaluation tool) provided by WebAIM, manual visual checks, screen reader, and code inspection.

In the search result, checkboxes are not labeled.

Pagination controls do not have a labeled purpose.

On Search page, date fields From and To fields don't have sufficient labels informing the users what the dates are for. "Living in the year(s), Date of first publication, Date first performed, etc.

On Search page in the Keyword search option, the first dropdown is not labeled.

On Search page (applies to Annual Bib. Of English Language and Literature), Search in and Litit to checkboxes are not labeled properly (Search in and Limit to is not communicated).

On Search page (applies to MLA International Bibliography, African American poetry, English Poetry, English Poetry 2nd ed. (1st dropdown only)), Limit keyword to dropdowns are not labeled.

On Search page (applies to King James Bible), in the Go to section, Book, Chapter, and Verse fields are not labeled.

On Advanced search (applies to MLA International Bibliography), Publication year, Update code, Limit to fields are not labeled properly.
On Search when navigating to Directory of Periodicals, Publication type radio buttons are not labeled, Limited to checkbox group is not labeled.
