ProQuest History Vault consists of manuscript and archival collections digitized in partnership with a wide variety of archival institutions. Many of the collections in History Vault were originally available in microfilm from the University Publications of America (UPA) research collections, and others come from the University Microfilms International (UMI) research collections, with additional collections scanned from the original documents. ProQuest History Vault debuted in 2011 with about three million pages of material and will grow to **over 22.6 million pages with 63 different modules in 2022**. These millions of pages of important archival collections give students the opportunity to make new research discoveries in content areas like Southern Life, Slavery, and the Civil War; Civil Rights and the Black Freedom Struggle in the 20th Century; Women's Studies; American Politics and Society; and International Relations and Military Conflicts.

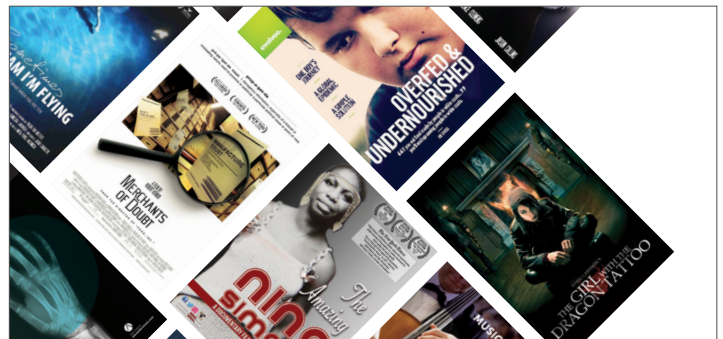
